Communication and Mutual Understanding Through Language, Culture and Art" is a course that focuses on understanding and exploring the relationship between culture, language and art in the context of intercultural dialogue and understanding. The goal of this course is to prepare participants to effectively communicate, collaborate and exchange with different cultures through a critical examination of language, cultural values and artistic expression. The exploration of important issues of human understanding in the age of geopolitics goes beyond the borders of a single country. This course emphasizes culture, language and art as key elements that form a strong foundation for any country's image.

During the Inaugural lecture, in addition to welcoming the course participants, the syllabus and the main assumptions of the BIP course will be presented and followed by the opening lecture. This course examines culture, language, and art from the perspective of Intercultural Communication and Mutual Understanding.

The opening lecture will introduce students to selected works of foreign literature from a comparative and translational perspective. Fragments of literary works will be analyzed in a comparative aspect, incorporating the contexts of music and painting. The subsequent lecture will address translation issues and non-verbal communication.
