IMPACT OF THE RESEARCH.

His main research lines concerns Roman History and Latin Epigraphy of North Africa and Sardinia from the Punic times to the Vandals (Colonization, Romanization, Urbanization, Acculturation, Rural Landscape etc); municipal and tribal institutions (especially in Africa Proconsularis, Sardinia and Moesia Inferior); urban society, especially of Uchi Maius, Ammaedara and Thignica in Africa, Forum Traiani, Tarrhi in Sardinia;

clarissimi and equites in Africa and Sardinia; Roman soldiers and veterans in imperial times; Roman society at campaigns of North Africa, Sardinia, Baetica and Lower Moesia; Onomastic Studies; cultural relationships between Romans and Natives; biographies of emperors and senatorial aristocracy; prosopography; growth and decline of the towns; economy and trade; exploitation of the resources of a territory; spectacles at amphitheater; history of Latin epigraphy; funerary epigraphy; mosaics with inscriptions; instrumentum.
