The workshop will take place on 1–2 December 2025 at the Department of Economics and Business, University of Sassari.

- **Postdocs and Assistant Professors** will deliver **short research sketches** outlining their lines of inquiry and methods.
- **Auditors** are welcome for networking and discussion.
