MOBILITY GRANTS FOR STUDENTS FROM UKRAINIAN HEIs
A.Y. 2025/26

Purpose of the Call

According to the decisions adopted by the European Commission aimed at facing the humanitarian emergency caused by the ongoing conflict in Ukraine, the University of Sassari (UNISS) offers Erasmus+ mobility grants for students enrolled in a Ukrainian University. Applicants may choose to carry out a study or traineeship mobility at UNISS. To be eligible, students must have enrolled at a Ukrainian University before the start of the conflict.

Mobility grants available

For the A.Y. 2025/26 the following Erasmus+ mobility grants are available:

- N. 4 mobility grants for study or traineeship, for a maximum duration of 5 months each.

Student mobility type

Eligible activities for students include:

A) STUDY MOBILITY

- Full time study activities (lessons, exams or thesis preparation or all of them).
- Additional traineeship activities, to be defined with the relevant hosting Department.

B) TRAINEESHIP MOBILITY

- Full time traineeship activities.

Student mobility duration and financial support

The mobility period must have a minimum duration of 2 months. Shorter periods are not eligible. The study/traineeship mobility will run from March till July 2026. In case of traineeships, the relevant mobility periods are specified for each position.

The mobility activity must be carried out by 31/07/2026 at the latest.

In case the selected participants cannot carry out at least 60 days of mobility due to force majeure, the Erasmus+ Italian National Agency might consider recognising the mobility period





carried out and the corresponding funding.

Each mobility grant for students amounts to € 1,150 per month, including:

- Euro 900.00 per month as individual support
- Euro 250.00 per month as top-up for students with fewer opportunities

Selected students will be exempted from paying any tuition fee at UNISS as foreseen by the Erasmus+ Program regulations.

Incompatibility

The mobility grants offered under the present call are not compatible with other grants offered by the University of Sassari to Ukrainian students and staff. If candidates are awarded more than one grant, they may choose which grant accept for the whole duration of the mobility period.

Application requirements for students

Eligible applicants are required to be regularly enrolled in a Ukrainian Higher Education Institution at the time of application. Only students who were already enrolled before the start of the war can apply.

Applicants are required to provide evidence of their enrolment by submitting at least one of the following documents **in English**:

- certificate of enrolment
- declarations issued by competent Ukrainian Higher Education Institutions or authorities, stating the enrolment at a Ukrainian Higher Education Institution

In case of mobility for traineeship, students must meet the specific requirements specified for each position. Eligible applications will be subject to final approval by the host institution/company.

Travel grant

Selected students will receive a contribution for travel (1 round-trip flight ticket per beneficiary), based on the travel distances calculated using the distance calculator tool (<https://erasmus-plus.ec.europa.eu/resources-and-tools/distance-calculator>), as follows:

Travel distance	Amount
Between 10 and 99 km	€ 28.00
Between 100 and 499 km	€ 211.00
Between 500 and 1999 km	€ 309.00
Between 2000 and 2999 km	€ 395.00
Between 3000 and 3999	€ 580.00
Between 4000 and 7999	€ 1188.00

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Applications must be submitted by filling the application form available [HERE](#).

At the end of the application process, candidates must upload:





1. Copy of their passport or ID certifying the holder's identity.
2. Certificates of enrolment or declarations issued by competent Ukrainian Higher Education Institutions or authorities, stating the enrolment at a Ukrainian Higher Education Institution (**documentation required in English**)
3. In case of study mobility: Learning Agreement for Studies (.docx or .odt file), **ANNEX I**, duly filled in as follows:
 - Table A, must include the list of the courses to follow at UNISS.
 - Table B must include the list of the corresponding courses at applicant's home University.

Before the start of the mobility, it will be necessary to sign an Inter-Institutional Agreement between the University of Sassari and the sending institution of the selected students/staff.

DEADLINES:

Applications are open until **12 January 2026**.

Mobility grants will be assigned on a first-come-first-served basis. Only complete applications, complying with the admission requirements, will be accepted. In case of applications for traineeships, eligible applications will be subject to final approval by the host institution/company.

Accepted candidates will be provided with the relevant information to complete all the required administrative procedures for the Erasmus mobility period before the mobility.

Before the start of the mobility it will be required to sign an Inter-Institutional Agreement between the university of Sassari and the sending institution of the selected participants.
