

**Annex E – Privacy Notice****PRIVACY NOTICE ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA PURSUANT TO THE GDPR (GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION – REGULATION (EU) 2016/679 ON THE PROTECTION OF NATURAL PERSONS WITH REGARD TO THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA) AND LEGISLATIVE DECREE NO. 196/2003 (ITALIAN PRIVACY CODE)**

You are hereby informed that, through the submission of the application and the related attachments for the public comparative selection procedure of which this notice forms an integral part as Annex E, the University of Sassari acquires your personal data in compliance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data, for the period strictly necessary for the use of such data within the related administrative procedure. The data will be processed in accordance with the principles of lawfulness, necessity, proportionality, relevance, and fairness, in compliance with the applicable legislation and the regulations adopted by the University.

A) PURPOSES AND METHODS OF PROCESSING

Personal data, in compliance with applicable legislation:

- a) shall be processed lawfully, fairly, and transparently;
- b) shall be collected for specified, explicit, and legitimate purposes;
- c) shall be adequate, relevant, and limited to what is necessary in relation to the purposes for which they are processed;
- d) shall be accurate and, where necessary, kept up to date;
- e) shall be stored in a form which permits identification of the data subject for no longer than is necessary for the purposes for which the data are processed;
- f) shall be processed in a manner that ensures appropriate security, including protection against unauthorized or unlawful processing and against accidental loss, destruction, or damage, by means of appropriate technical and organizational measures. Processing will be carried out using both manual/paper-based and/or electronic and telematic tools, for which specific security measures are adopted to guarantee the security, integrity, and confidentiality of the data, in order to address risks of destruction, loss, alteration, unauthorized access, or unauthorized disclosure.

B) NATURE OF DATA PROVISION AND CONSEQUENCES OF REFUSAL

Failure to provide the requested data prevents the University's administrative offices from carrying out activities related to the specific procedure; therefore, any refusal will make it impossible to fulfill the aforementioned purpose.

C) DISCLOSURE AND DISSEMINATION OF DATA

In compliance with the provisions concerning Administrative Transparency (Italian Legislative Decree No. 33 of 14 March 2013 and related legislation), data, information, and documents subject to mandatory publication, including curricula vitae, will be disseminated through publication on the University website, limited to non-sensitive personal data functional to transparency obligations. Without prejudice to the above, data may also be communicated, in accordance with the law, to police authorities, judicial authorities, intelligence and security bodies, or other public entities for purposes of defense, state security, crime prevention and prosecution, as well as communicated to the judicial authority in compliance with legal obligations.

D) DATA CONTROLLER, DATA PROCESSOR, AND DATA PROTECTION OFFICER (DPO)

E) RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT

By contacting the Data Processor at the addresses indicated above, you, as data subject, may at any time obtain confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning you exist, and be informed of their content and origin, verify their accuracy, or request their integration, updating, or rectification (Art. 7 of Italian Legislative Decree No. 196/2003).

You may also exercise the rights provided for by the GDPR, including:

- the right to request further information regarding the contents of this notice (Arts. 13 and 14);
- the right of access to your personal data (Art. 15);
- the right to rectification of inaccurate personal data and completion of incomplete personal data (Art. 16);
- the right to erasure/right to be forgotten (where provided by law) (Art. 17);
- the right to restriction of processing (Art. 18);
- the right to data portability (where provided by law) (Art. 20).
