### EUNICOAST Project Student Contest 2026 "Waves of Change"

**To whom it may concern / dear participant**, we wish to inform you that the University of Sassari, as part of the EUNICOAST Alliance / Project – the European University of Islands, Ports and Coastal Territories — is launching the first Contest for visual/audiovisual works, and commits itself to ensuring that your personal data are: (a) processed lawfully, fairly and in a transparent manner; (b) collected for specified, explicit and legitimate purposes; (c) adequate, relevant and limited to what is necessary in relation to the purposes for which they are processed; (d) accurate and, where necessary, kept up to date; (e) kept in a form which permits identification of data subjects for no longer than is necessary for the purposes for which the personal data are processed; (f) processed in a manner that ensures appropriate security of the personal data, including protection against unauthorised or unlawful processing and against accidental loss, destruction or damage, using appropriate technical or organisational measures.

Through this document, we inform you about **which categories of personal data** we will process, **who will process it and why**, **how** and **for how long**, as well as **how to exercise your rights** in this regard.

**(17) Source of Personal Data not obtained directly from the Data Subject**

The Data Controller will process personal data provided directly by you, the data subject.

**(18) How we process personal data, means/methods/security measures**

Processing will be carried out through IT tools and paper-based means, with specific and appropriate security measures to guarantee the security, integrity, availability and confidentiality of data and to address risks of destruction, loss, alteration, unauthorised access or disclosure. Processing may include “*operations (...) such as collection, recording, organisation, structuring, storage, adaptation or alteration, retrieval, consultation, use, disclosure by transmission, dissemination or otherwise making available, alignment or combination, restriction, erasure or destruction*” (Art. 4 GDPR).

**(19) Automated decision-making**

The processing **does not involve** the activation of an automated decision-making process (including profiling)

**(20) Rights of the Data Subject (Art. 15 to 22 and Art. 13 GDPR)**

By contacting the Data Controller or the Data Protection Officer at the addresses above indicated, you have the right to: access your personal data (Art. 15 GDPR); request further information on the content of this notice (Artt. 13–14); rectification of inaccurate data and completion of incomplete data (Art. 16); erasure/right to be forgotten (Art. 17); restriction of processing (Art. 18); data portability where applicable (Art. 20); and the right to object (Art. 21). For processing based on consent, you have the right to withdraw consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing carried out prior to withdrawal (Art. 7 c.3 GDPR).
