HAVING CONSIDERED MIUR memo No. 6363 of March 11, 2016, dictating the operational guide-lines for the accreditation procedures of post-graduate schools and courses for the 2017/2018 academic year, and setting April 31st, 2016 as the deadline for the submission of applications via the national post-graduate education on-line portal, limited to already accredited courses;

HAVING CONSIDERED MIUR memo of the Ministry of Education of 19/05/2017 Reg. no. 14962, with which the above expiration date was postponed to 06/07/2017;

HAVING CONSIDERED MIUR memo No. 19415 of July 10, 2017 granting the University of Sassari the authorization to issue the public call pending the publication of the Ministerial Decree governing the accreditation of PhD courses;

WHEREAS the M.D. regarding the accreditation of doctoral courses is still to be published;

HAVING CONSIDERED the call published by the Autonomous Region of Sardinia on June 10, 2016, for the funding of PhD scholarships - Year 2016, and its Annexes A), B) and C) - POR FSE 2014/2020;

HAVING CONSIDERED the project proposal submitted to the Autonomous Region of Sardinia for the funding of PhD scholarships for the XXXII and XXXIII cycles by the University of Sassari on June 27, 2016;

HAVING CONSIDERED the memo issued by the Autonomous Region of Sardinia - Department of Education, Culture, Entertainment and Sports - Directorate-General of Education - University and Youth Policy Service, Reg. n. 8329 of 7 July 2016, by which the approval of the project proposal submitted by the University on 27/06/2016 is confirmed;

HAVING CONSIDERED that the additional funds will be allocated to fund scholarships to enforce Action I.1 of PON RI 2014-2020 and that, therefore, available scholarships could be more than those referred to in this announcement for PhD courses for the 2017/2018, cycle, with administrative hq at the University of Sassari;

DOES HEREBY DECREE

ART. 1 – Announcement

The University of Sassari does hereby announce the XXXIII call for Doctoral Research Courses.

Calls are open based on qualifications and examinations for admission to the PhD courses listed below, for each of which the number of positions available are reported, the number and type of grants, the titles that will be subject to evaluation by the Selection Panel, the topics of the research project and their date, time, place and oral examination mode.

The grants funded with POR Sardegna FSE 2014/2020 are intended to help strengthen higher education, ensuring its consistency with the needs of the regional productive system and the smart specialisation strategy 2014/2020 of the Sardinian Regional Authority, through the education and training identified in priority III – thematic objective 10 "investing in education, training and vocational training for skills and lifelong learning"-investment priorities 10ii) "improving the quality and efficiency of higher education and of an equivalent level and access to it in order to increase the participation and success rates especially for disadvantaged groups"-specific objective 10.5 "raising of skills levels, educational participation and success in higher education and/or equivalent"-Action of the partnership agreement 10.5.12 "actions for the strengthening of higher education or equivalent degree, aimed at promoting the link between education, the production system, research institutions, with particular reference to PhD programmes in collaboration with businesses and/or research bodies in scientific fields consistent with the strategic guidelines of the National Research Program (NRP) and the Smart regional Specialisation" under D.G.R. n. 47/14 of 29 September 2015. The grants funded with POR Sardegna FSE 2014-2020 must be consistent with the strategic lines of PNR and of Smart Specialisation of the Autonomous Region of Sardinia relating to the areas of specialization (AdS) referred to in the D.G.R. n. 43/12 1 September 2015, as reported in the sections dedicated to the PhD courses.

The scholarships funded under such legislative device are intended for candidates who meet the requirements for admission prescribed by art. 2, ranked among the first in the merit list to fill vacancies, which reside in Sardinia at the date of registration in the PhD programme.

The PhD courses enjoying grants funded under the POR FSE programme, are the same approved by the regional administration with determination no. 130 prot. no. 8296 of 6 July 2016.

Aims and Objectives:

The environmental question imposes the need to rethink, in a sustainable and permissible manner, ways of inhabiting our towns, our organisation of public spaces and territories, the design of everyday objects and their reuse, the building materials we use, our modes of transportation, the way we manage land and water, how to safeguard landscapes, how to recompose the urban form and how to innovate production processes and technologies. The doctoral programme is open to students from different disciplinary fields who want to understand and become capable of analysing the relationship between the built environment and the ecosystems in order to design, plan and manage its transformations. This requires a multidisciplinary approach to the system: the boundaries of disciplines and their theories do not address the issue of sustainability in an integrated manner.

Interdisciplinary PhD course is consistent in contents, objectives and methodological approach. It focuses on architecture and the environmental design of space starting from ecological, geological and environmental know-how. The goal is to make sustainability "abstract" in terms of actual "permissibility", dealing with tangible and intangible objects, in connection with functions, facilities and environmental processes, but also to redevelop, recover, restore, rethink, reuse, recycle, reduce it.

The doctoral programme aims to train researchers able to operate autonomously and with competence for research institutions and the academia. However, the PhD fellow in architecture and the environment is also a high-profile professional that can operate autonomously or as a member of research institutions or public and local bodies, trained for project management at different levels: archaeological, architectural, environmental, urban and territorial.

The researcher can find a position in research, education, freelance, public administration and private enterprises, as a manager, coordinator and fund-raiser. A highly skilled professional with the technical expertise and who can deal with the problems posed by the complexity of urban and territorial realities and in particular by the environmental crisis and a "sustainable development" such as: living in and the evolution of the built environment; architectural and archaeological heritage; towns and countryside; environment, land and landscape; geology and environment; the city of rights; the multidimensional project and plan; the objects that make us smart.

Finally, the PhD fellow could act as a knowledge-broker, a figure not yet fully known in Italy, on which the European Union is turning its attention. A knowledge broker is a highly qualified person able to communicate and make knowledge understandable and can set it in the right place in professional contexts or consultancy services for both public and private enterprises, since it is used in the correct way, combining effectively supply and demand in different contexts.

Aims and Objectives:

The PhD course is aimed at promoting a high-level scientific research in the following fields:

- agrometeorology and ecophysiology of agricultural and forestry ecosystems;
- crop production;
- management of agricultural and forestry production systems, and conservation, protection and enhancement of natural resources;
- integrated monitoring of the territory for the application of systemic forest management in sustainable silviculture;
- ecological dynamics of pre-forestry and forestry systems in relation to the effects of disturbance factors, to adaptation to climate change and to the prevention of forest fires in Mediterranean forests and in the wildland-urban interface;
- general and applied microbiology, molecular biology, biochemistry, enzymology, immunology, fermentation, chemistry and process engineering;
- animal rearing and breeding, nutrition and feeding, applied genetics and selection, including the use of molecular biology techniques, and quality and safety of products of animal origin.

During the three-year-course, doctoral students will acquire knowledge of the experimental scientific method and related expertise in planning experimental designs, conducting laboratory and field trials, mathematical and statistical processing of data, developing statistical and experimental inferences and disseminating research results.

Aims and Objectives: The PhD program develops research training activities in many fields of Veterinary Science. The objectives and activities of research concern livestock and pets. ART. 2 – Minimum admission requirements

All applicants are required to be in possession of a valid Masters' Degree certificate or an equivalent academic degree pursuant to M.D. no. 509 of 3 November 1999, and M.D. no. 270 of 22 October 2004, or a degree obtained under the previous university system (prior to D.M. no. 509 of 3 November 1999) or other equivalent qualification obtained abroad.

Applicants benefiting from POR FSE 2014/2020 grants, must be permanent residents in Sardinia at the time of registration to the PhD course.

For admission purposes, foreign citizens, whose qualifications are yet to be validated, shall formally request validation to the PhD Course Council when submitting their application form and attach any document that may be necessary to the Board to issue an equivalence report, pursuant to art. 5 provisions. Any original document written in a language other than Italian must be translated into Italian and stamped by the Italian consulate or diplomatic authority based in the applicant's country of origin or residence, in compliance with current Italian regulations on foreign student admission to Italian universities.

The foreign applicants who do not have any document translated into Italian, may submit a self-certification stating their compliance with the relevant requirements. Applicants shall then be admitted *sub condicione* and, should they be selected they shall be required to submit the above documentation **by 31 October 2017**, under penalty of exclusion.

All foreign applicants having a foreign academic qualification yet to be validated as equivalent to an Italian qualification to an Italian degree, the same provisions apply.

ART. 3 – Grants for foreign students

Each Graduate School may assign a single grant to one of those foreign students who successfully pass the examination, under art. 6 and 7 provisions.

Foreign applicants (both EU and non-EU) who wish to apply for the “foreign student” grant selection procedure are required to explicitly request for it when they submit their application form.

ART. 4 – Application procedure

ART. 6 – Exam

The examination procedure to the Doctoral courses will include an evaluation of previous qualifications, the research project and an interview. The mark will be expressed in points out of 100 (30+20+50). The evaluation is intended to assess the experience and expertise of the applicant, his/her bent for scientific research and his/her proficiency in a language other than Italian, as expressly requested by the PhD School.

Entry exams may be held in Italian or English or other EU language, upon request of the applicant and upon approval of the Board, during the examination session.

The details concerning the interview, reporting their date, place and time, shall be added to each of the course data sheets. It will therefore not be communicated to the applicants.

Applicants shall be granted access to the examination premises upon submission of a valid ID, passport, driving license, post card, gun license, personal identification card issued by public authorities, identical to that submitted with the application form. Failure to provide such documents will result in the exclusion from the examination procedure.

The interview will be conducted, as requested by the applicant in the ANNEX A form, at the premises indicated for each Course in art. 1 or via Skype call, within the times reported for each course in art. 1.

Applicants who opt for the Skype conversation must connect with the designated Skype contact within the scheduled time reported for each course in art. 1 of this notice, in such a way that the examination board has enough time to complete the necessary procedures for the recognition of the candidate.

Just like the one made on site, this method of participation is also public.

Candidates who will opt for the online mode must be aware that technical drawbacks might take place by choosing this mode.

The final ranking list shall be drafted based on the results of the oral examination, including the research project and qualification evaluation, and shall be published on www.uniss.it.

ART. 7 – The Boards of Examiners and their requirements

The Board of Examiners of each course shall be summoned pursuant to the University set of rules and regulations on graduate courses

The board may award up to 100 points for the evaluation of each applicant, broken up as follows:

- up to a maximum of 30 points for the valuation of qualifications;
- up to a maximum of 20 points for the valuation of the research project;
- up to a maximum of 50 points for the interview;

The 30 points for the valuation of qualifications are defined as follows:

- Final grade (up to a maximum of 15 points):

- up to 100 – 0 points;
- between 100 and 104 – 2 points;
- between 105 and 107 – 4 points;
- between 108 and 109 – 6 points;
- 110/110 – 10 points;
- 110/110 with honours – 15 points;

- Publications (up to a maximum of 10 points): a **maximum** of 5 publications can be attached, with research topics related to the PhD course chosen by the applicant. The type of publication that will be evaluated by the selection board is provided in the specific chart of each PhD programme in art. 1 of this call.

- Other university degrees (up to a maximum of 5 points): the candidate may indicate only one qualification among the Master's degree, specialization diplomas, research grants, postgraduate qualifications equivalent to those listed, documented research contracts with universities or research institutes, both Italian and foreign.
- The qualification so identified by the candidate must be consistent with the research areas of the doctoral programme he/she intends to apply to.

The score assigned to each of the candidates admitted to the competition *sub conditione* will not be revised as a result of graduation by the applicant.

The research project must obtain a result of at least 12/20 to be admitted to the interview.

The list of selected candidates will be published and signed by the President and the Secretary on www.uniss.it. The interview is successfully passed if the candidate gets a mark higher than 30/50. During the interview, language proficiency in a foreign language will be verified, without attribution of any score. At the end of each session dedicated to the interview, the selection board drafts the list of interviewed candidates with the relevant marks. The list, signed by the President and the Secretary of the Panel, is posted on the same day at the Department where the interview was taken. **This list is not to be considered as the official appointment of the winners.** The final list will be published on the www.uniss.it website upon approval of the competition reports.

ART. 8 – Registration

After the completion of the examination phases, the Panel shall establish the ranking of merit on the basis of the sum of the points awarded to each candidate in the evaluation of qualifications, the research project and the interview. Selected candidates are admitted to the PhD programme on the basis of the merit list until the full assignment of available positions. The list may be either a single list or divided by specialization, according to the determination of the courses as reported in this call.

In case of failure or late acceptance by the beneficiaries, the next candidate on the merit list will take over, provided a month has not passed since the beginning of the course.

In case of equal merit between candidate for the awarding of the scholarship or a place with a scholarship the Decree “DPCM del 9 aprile 2001” (artt. 4 e 5) will be applied. Otherwise, in case of allocation of a place without a grant between candidates having equal merit, the younger age will be considered.

ART. 9 – Matriculation

Matriculation applications of selected students must be submitted by the set deadlines and will be published once the call procedures are over and the ranking lists are published, on UNISS website www.uniss.it.

ART. 10 – Attendance

All applicants are expected to attend and participate in the PhD course activities as full-time students, as specified in the course requirements approved by the Doctoral Board.

At the end of each academic year, students will submit a detailed report of the research work carried out until that stage. Annual reports are assessed by a Board of Examiners who takes record of students' progress, thereby advising the Rector as to their prospective status.

The qualification of “Dottore di Ricerca” (Ph.D.) is awarded to fellows who complete the course and achieve a positive assessment of their doctoral thesis by the Examination panel.

ART. 11 – Grant rejection or withdrawal

Applicants who fail to submit all relevant documentation by the afore-mentioned deadline will not be admitted to the courses. False statements are punished in accordance with current applicable regulations. If no applicant is selected for one or more courses, or eligible applicants withdraw their application, the board will provide redistribution of available scholarships.

ART. 12 – Scholarships

The scholarships, the number of which is indicated for each PhD programme in art. 1, are assigned by the selection boards, following comparative assessment of merit and according to the order defined in the respective merit rankings or their curricula, if the course planned to do so.

The annual amount of the scholarship, which is determined in accordance with art. 1 of D.M. 18 June 2008 amounts to € 13,638.47 gross of employee benefit expenses borne by the recipient.

In case of a tie in the merit list between candidates, the provisions of art. 8 shall apply.

The scholarships reserved for foreign nationals, if not assigned, may be reassigned pursuant to art. 9 the regulations governing University PhD courses.

The scholarships have a duration of one year and are renewed on condition that the student has completed the programme of activities for the previous year, verified according to the procedures laid down in the PhD programme, subject to the requirement to assign the scholarship after the successful completion of the examination procedure.

The assignment of a scholarship for a PhD programme is compatible with having a gross annual personal income derived from self-employment not exceeding € 15,000.00 in the calendar year when the scholarship is assigned.

The PhD scholarship starts from 1 November 2016 and may not be combined with any other scholarship granted except with those granted by national or foreign institutions to integrate research stays abroad, nor with other research grants.

The amount of the scholarship is increased for mobilities abroad by 50%, subject to the availability of funds.

The request for the additional funds, addressed to the Rector, shall be subject to the authorization issued by the Coordinator of the course who will authorize the mobility abroad, within the limit of six months, or by the Academic panel for longer periods.

The study grant payment is made on a deferred monthly basis.

The grants funded with POR Sardegna FSE 2014-2020 will be awarded only to candidates who are selected and reside in Sardinia at the date of registration to the PhD programme.

Grant beneficiaries must formally declare their availability to carry out the study and research stays abroad for at least 6 months during the three-year course and be aware that failure to do so may result in the withdrawal of the entire scholarship.

Those who have received a scholarship for a PhD programme, cannot benefit from a second grant.

ART. 13 – Tuition fees

The fees to access and attend a PhD course set by the academic bodies of the University amount to **€ 354.23** for the **first year** (including the University's contribution, stamp duty and insurance coverage against accidents and civil liability) and to **€ 338.23** for **each of the following two years** (including the University's contribution and insurance against accidents and civil liability).

The first-year registration fee must be paid by MAV within the deadline set at the issuing and publication of the merit list.

The fees for the following years must be paid via MAV by 31 December of each year.

Exemption from the payment of the University contribution, but not of the insurance and stamp duty, is granted to students with special needs with a disability degree equal to or greater than 66%, which must be declared upon registration.

ART. 14 – Person responsible for the proceeding

Pursuant to art. 4 of Italian Law No 241 of 7 August 1990 and following amendments (“Nuove norme in materia di procedimento amministrativo e di diritto di accesso ai documenti amministrativi”), Dr. Anna Paola Vargiu, Head of the Post Graduate Education Bureau, shall stand in her capacity as the person responsible for the proceeding.

Candidates are entitled to exercise the right of get access to all the documents in the procedure in the manner provided or on the website <https://www.uniss.it/urp>.

ART. 15 - Privacy

Pursuant to L.D. No 196 of 30 June 2003 (“Codice in materia di protezione dei dati personali”) on the use and protection of personal data and, in particular, to the provisions stated in art. 13, all sensible data provided by the applicants shall be collected by the Università degli Studi di Sassari for the purposes herewith and will be processed digitally. The use of all personal data shall be governed by the above legislation until the matriculation procedure is over for all applicants, according to the institutional aims and purposes.

The granting of this data is mandatory in order to assess participation requirements, under penalty of exclusion from the selection process.

All submitted information may be transmitted to any public agency that might be interested in collecting information on the academic status of the applicants or the entry test procedure.

All applicants enjoy the rights stated in artt. 7, 8, 9 and 10 of the above-mentioned L.D., including their right to access, modify, update their personal data and delete any information that may be inconsistent, incomplete or collected in manners not pursuant to the law. They also have the right to prevent their transmission to third parties for legitimate reasons.
