## DOES HEREBY DECREE

### Article 1

An announcement is made for public selections, by qualification assessment and interview, for the awarding of 1 (one) 12-month research fellowships sponsored by the Department of Chemistry and Pharmacy of the University of Sassari, pursuant to art. 22 of the Italian Law no. 240 dated 30 December 2010, paragraph 4, letter b, as specified in the following paragraphs:

## Article 2 Eligibility requirements

Both Italian and foreign applicants meeting at least one of the following specific requirements are eligible to participate in the selection procedure:

- PhD or equivalent issued by Italian or foreign universities relevant to the scientific area above or to the





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project proposal, chosen by the applicant,  
pursuant to art. 1 of this Decree;

b) Master's degree or equivalent, in addition to a professional postgraduate scientific experience relevant to the research activities gained in at least two years of scientific activities, relevant to the scientific area or the project proposal, chosen by the applicant, pursuant to art. 1 of this Decree; *"possession of professional scientific experience suitable for conducting research activities, gained in at least two years of scientific activities" means the following objectively documented activities: previous experience as research fellowship/scholarship beneficiary; regional and/or national and/or international research projects; author or coauthor of scientific publications over the time-frame of reference."*

The possession of a PhD title is to be considered as a **preferential qualification** for admission purposes as referred to in art. 1 of this Decree.

**The relevance of the specific requirements will be assessed by the Selection Panel.**

The eligibility requirements mentioned above must be fulfilled within the deadline for the submission of applications.

Limited to the qualifications issued abroad by foreign institutions, the applicant is required to provide the details of the document certifying its recognition in Italy pursuant to current applicable regulations (*dichiarazione di equipollenza* - statement of equivalence). In the event that such recognition is still being processed, the applicant may submit a Statement of Equal Value (*dichiarazione di equivalenza*) for the purpose of participating in the selection procedure, issued (pursuant to art. 38 of the Italian Legislative Decree 165/2001 as amended and supplemented) by the competent Italian authority.

Applicants having a qualification issued abroad by a foreign institution who cannot provide all required documents before the deadline of the comparative procedure, will be admitted with reservation and will be required to provide all necessary documents if selected. Applicants failing to provide such documentation will be excluded from the selection.

The Administration ensures equality and equal opportunity between men and women with regard to access to employment and treatment at work.

### Article 3

#### *Submission of the application and deadlines*

Applicants shall submit their applications, filled in on unstamped paper, to the attention of "Magnifico Rettore dell'Università degli Studi di Sassari, Piazza Università n. 21 - 07100 Sassari", within **20 (twenty) days after the publication date of this announcement.**

Application forms and their annexes may be **delivered by hand** to the Registrar's Office (Ufficio Protocollo) of this University, **by registered letter with acknowledgment of receipt** or by using an Italian **PEC (Certified Electronic Mail) service** to send an email solely to the following institutional PEC address: [protocollo@pec.uniss.it](mailto:protocollo@pec.uniss.it).

If a PEC service is used, the application and all required annexes attached must be forwarded in one of the following ways:

Any application registered after the deadline reported in this announcement will be rejected.

**No amendment/supplement to the application may be accepted after the deadline reported in this announcement.**

In the application form, the candidate shall include, on pain of exclusion, all the information necessary to identify unequivocally the name of the Department sponsoring the procedure, the competition sector, the academic disciplinary sector and the research project which the candidate is applying to.

In the application form and its annexes, signed if required, on pain of exclusion, the candidate shall declare:

- his/her surname and name, date of birth, place of birth and his/her Italian tax code;
- his/her municipality of residence and address;
- his/her citizenship;
- that he/she enjoy all civil and political rights (for foreign candidates, also in his/her home-state or country of origin);

- that he/she is acquainted with no condition which may result in incompatibility and/or exclusion from the selection as provided for by art. 8 of this announcement;
- whether currently he/she is an employee or a freelance professional;
- whether he/she is enrolled in a degree course, the holder of a research fellowship or medical specialization fellowship;
- that he/she is in possession of the specific requirements described in art. 2 of this Decree;
- that he/she requests to perform the interview by electronic means, through a Skype video conference call (or equivalent);





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Applicants with special needs must include in the application form the request to benefit from special devices or assistance based on their disability, or specify the need to be granted an extension of the time available for the examination phase, pursuant to the Italian Law no. 104 dated 5 February 1992, 104.

This University does not take any responsibility for failure to receive communications or late notifications of any information connected to this procedure, not attributable to this University, but due to postal or telegraphic error, or errors attributable to third parties, chance or force majeure.

This Announcement also includes (Ann. "A") the application form that all applying candidates are required to use.

Candidates shall enclose in their application:

- non-certified copy of a valid identification document in electronic format and a copy of the Italian tax code;
- a scientific-professional curriculum, dated and signed;
- the qualifications to be assessed by the Evaluation Panel;
- the list of attached qualifications, dated and signed;
- the publications;
- any document reporting the details of the Statement of Equivalence of the qualification issued abroad by a foreign institution, pursuant to current applicable regulations, or any document certifying the Equal Value of the qualification for the purpose of participating in this selection, or the Statement of Equivalence request submitted to the competent Italian authorities.

Candidates shall prove the possession of qualifications, except publications, in the simplified form of administrative certifications allowed by art. 46 and 47 of the Italian Decree of the President of the Republic 445/2000 and art. 15 of the Italian Law no. 183 dated 12 November 2011 (Stability Act 2012), by filling Annex "B".

Publications may be attached in original copy or certified copy, pursuant to art. 19 of the Italian Decree of the President of the Republic 445/2000, by providing a statement in lieu of a notarized document ("dichiarazione sostitutiva dell'atto di notorietà") pursuant to art. 47 of the above-mentioned Italian Decree of the President of the Republic (annex C).

The candidate may use a form for each submitted qualification, including the publications for which a certified copy is submitted, by attaching the form to each copy, or as an alternative, provide a cumulative statement in lieu of notarized documents. In this case, the statement shall contain the details necessary to identify each individual qualification.

A non-certified copy of a valid identification document in electronic format, including a photograph, shall be attached to the substitute statements of certification and the statements in lieu of notarized documents, as provided for by the Italian Decree of the President of the Republic 445/2000. The





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Administration reserves the right to verify the truthfulness of the statements made in the substitute statements.

Reference shall not be made to documents or publications submitted to this or other authorities, or other documents attached to the application forms to another competition.

#### Article 4

##### *Appointment of the Examination Panel and examinations*

The comparative examination procedure shall be performed by qualification assessment and interview.

The qualification assessment shall be performed before the interview.

The interview consists of a test designed to verify the level of knowledge necessary to carry out the research programme.

As for the candidates' qualification assessment and interview, a dedicated Examination Panel shall be appointed and summoned by decree of the Director of the Department sponsoring the selection procedure, upon proposal of the Department Board and consisting of the Project manager and two other members, the latter being professors or researchers having the same scientific area as the research project or areas consistent with it.

The decree appointing the Examination Panel shall be published on the website of the University of Sassari at: <http://www.uniss.it/ateneo>, at "Bandi, Concorsi e Gare" in section "Bandi per docenti, ricercatori e assegnisti di ricerca".

The Department sponsoring the selection shall notify the appointment in written form to the members of the Panel.

The Examination Panel shall establish the following assessment criteria to be used during the examination procedure, specified in detail so that the global evaluation shall be expressed in hundredths, and not exceed the following maximum values:

##### 40 points for qualifications, divided as follows:

- PhD or medical specialization qualification relevant to the scientific area being sponsored or the research project reported in art. 1 of this announcement: **up to a maximum of 20 points**;
- publications, specialization diplomas or certificates of attendance for post-graduate courses issued in Italy or abroad, and documented research activity performed on behalf of public or private organizations as an employee, research fellow or hired professional in Italy or abroad, as





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long as they are consistent with the scientific area reported in this announcement or with the research project reported in art. 1 of this announcement: **up to a maximum of 20 points;**

### 60 points for the interview.

The interview phase is considered successful if the candidate is assigned at least 40 point out of 60.

In order to be admitted to the interview, the candidates admitted with reservation pursuant to art. 1 of this announcement, shall provide a valid identification document.

**The candidates who are not able to participate in the interview at the location and at the time notified, may request to be interviewed by electronic means, through an IP-based video conference call on a device equipped with a web-cam so as to allow proper identification by the Examination Panel; such request must be duly authorized by the Examination Panel and it is subject to verification that the interview is performed in a fair way (verification of the candidate's identity and fairness during the interview).**

Once the tests have been carried out, the Committee will draw up the relevant ranking list by summing the score assigned to the submitted qualifications and publications, and to the interview, thus declaring the successful candidate.

**A candidate is included in the ranking list if he/she obtains a score of at least 60 points out of 100.**

The ranking list shall be approved by decree of the General Director.

The Administration shall publish the result of the selection procedure in the website of the University of Sassari at: <http://www.uniss.it/ateneo>, on page "Bandi, Concorsi e Gare" in section "Bandi per docenti, ricercatori e assegnisti di ricerca", and by written notification to the successful candidates and the candidates included in the ranking list.

**The exclusion of a candidate due to failure to meet any of the requirements reported in art. 2 of this announcement may be ordered at any time by justified decree of the General Director.**

## Article 5

### *Selection calendar*

The selection calendar and the date of publication of eligible candidates admitted to the interview are included in Annex 1, which is an integral part of this Decree.

## Article 6

### *Awarding of the research fellowship and start of research activities*

The awarding of the research fellowship is formalized through the stipulation of a contract of private law between the University and the successful candidate.

The contract does not qualify as an employment contract and it does not give any right regarding access to any other position at the University of Sassari.

Since the year 2011, with respect to taxation, research fellowships have been subject to the provisions of





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art. 4 of the Italian Law no. 476 dated 13 August 1984, and with respect to social security, to those of art. 2, paragraph 26 and following, of the Italian Law no. 335 dated 8 August 1995, as amended; regarding the mandatory maternity leave, the provisions referred to in the Decree of the Italian Minister of Labour and Social Security dated 12 July 2007, published on the Italian Official Journal (G.U.) no. 247 dated 23 October 2007; and, as regards sickleave, art. 1, paragraph 788, of the Italian Law no. 296 dated 27 December 2006, as amended.

During the mandatory maternity leave, the indemnity paid by the Italian National Institute of Social Security (INPS) according to art. 5 of the above Decree dated 12 July 2007 will be supplemented by the University up to the full amount of the research fellowship.

The minimum gross annual amount of research fellowships, sponsored pursuant to art. 22 of the Italian Law no. 240 dated 30 December 2010, is EUR 19,367; such amount is net of the compulsory additional tax to be borne by the sponsoring Administration.

The fellowship is tax-exempt but it is subject to social security deductions (to be recalculated every three years), and disbursed on a monthly basis.

## Article 7

### *Duration and renewal*

Fellowships may have a duration between one and three years, depending on the duration of the project and subject to fund availability, they may be renewed for periods of time of at least one year, and they may not be combined with fellowships or grants of any kind, except those granted by national and foreign institutions which support researchers during their stays abroad.

The maximum duration of a fellowship, including renewals, is 6 (six) years, excluding the period of time simultaneous with the PhD course, for a duration equal to the legal duration of the course.

Maternity leaves or sick leaves are not included in the calculation of such duration, according to current applicable regulations.

As for the research fellowships awarded according to art. 3 of the University Rules on Research Fellowships, the renewals shall be approved by Rector's Decree, upon confirmation of available funds.

The renewal request shall be submitted to the Administration by the scientific manager, together with the report of the research fellow certifying the activity already carried out, at least 30 (thirty) days before the end of the contract, upon receipt of the positive opinion of the Department and the positive evaluation of the Examination Panel.

The Examination Panel consists of the same members of the Panel that ran the candidates' evaluation during the comparative procedure.

If one or some of the members of the Examination Panel are not available anymore, due to revocation or impediment, their replacement is ordered by Rector's Decree.





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## Article 8

### *Prohibition of plurality of offices - Incompatibility*

The research fellowship is individual; the beneficiary is entitled to attend doctoral programmes without the right to be awarded a fellowship, without prejudice to the admission to the examination procedure.

**Research fellows may not enroll in either first or second cycle university courses, PhD courses awarding fellowships, or medical specialization courses, in Italy or abroad.**

Research fellowships may not be awarded to candidates who have a family or kinship relationship, up to and including the fourth degree, with a Professor belonging to the department where the research activity is performed, or with the Rector, the General Director or a member of the Board of Directors of this University.

Since research fellows may not be employed by any organization, they shall be required to suspend their employment contracts and their remunerations for the whole duration of the research fellowship, including part-time contracts.

University employees are not eligible for research fellowships; private employees, including part-time employees, may not be assigned research fellowships.

## Art. 9

### *Rights and duties of research fellows*

Research fellows shall carry out the research activity specified in the contract signed with the scientific manager, have the right to use the research facilities and equipment of the Department where the research activity is carried out; if the activity is carried out in other facilities, such activity shall be duly authorized by the scientific manager and notified to the Administration.

The activity shall be carried out by the research fellows on a continuous basis, complying with the research programme and according to the specifications of the scientific manager, who shall supervise the activity carried out.

The research activity is suspended during the maternity leave, or in cases of inability due to the fellow's illness or illness of the fellow's family members, or due to voluntary suspension; the periods of suspension, except the mandatory suspension during maternity leave that is extended by right pursuant to current regulations, may be made up at the end of the natural termination of the contract, as agreed with the scientific manager and based on available funds and without any disbursement during the suspension period. Suspension periods of justified absence not exceeding 30 (thirty) working days on an annual basis, are not required to be made uprecouped.

Research fellows may carry out teaching activity, both paid and unpaid, as long as such activity does not interfere with planned research activities, as authorized by the scientific manager; the research fellow may not replace university scholars in their teaching and institutional activities and student evaluation sessions. The research fellow is entitled to the reimbursement of travel, board and lodging expenses and other reimbursable expenses, borne in Italy or abroad for research-related purposes, to be covered by departmental research funds, according to university regulations.





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If the research fellow intends to terminate the contract, he/she is required to notify the Rector and the Department of reference at least 30 days in advance.

If, after the termination of the contract by the research fellow, the remaining period exceeds one year, the Department has the right to announce a new selection for the remaining period; if the remaining period is shorter than one year, a new announcement may not be published and the remaining unused funds are reassigned to the sponsoring Department.

The research fellowship is revoked by the Rector upon justified request from the Director of the sponsoring Department and the contract is intended as terminated by right in case of: major non-compliance with work provisions or late start of research activities, or unjustified suspension of research activities and failure to comply with incompatibility-related provisions.

#### Article 10

##### *Processing of personal data and storing documents*

All personal data provided by the candidates will be processed by the University of Sassari pursuant to art. 19 of the Italian Legislative Decree no. 196 dated 30 June 2003. All data shall be processed according to legitimacy, need, limited manner, relevance and fairness, for the sole purposes connected and necessary to secure the comparative procedure and the subscription and management of the research contract, pursuant to the current law and the regulations of the University of Sassari.

Failure to provide the data requested to the relevant University units, may hinder the specific procedure and, therefore, refusing to provide such data will result in the impossibility to successfully complete the process.

The data acquired for the purposes of the selection procedure shall be processed in printed and digital form and only within the selection procedure for which they are provided and the procedures thereof. All acquired personal data shall be processed by the persons responsible and appointed by the University. Personal data shall not be forwarded and/or published, unless required by the law. However, upon request, data shall be provided pursuant to law provisions to the Police, judicial authorities, information and security organizations and other public authorities for purposes connected to the defense, State security, criminal investigations, and communication to the judicial authorities pursuant to legal provisions; data shall be stored pursuant to the Italian Legislative Decree no.196 dated 30 June 2003, for the time necessary to use such data within administrative procedures and pursuant to the provisions connected the storage of administrative and financial documents.

Data processing is a responsibility of the University of Sassari, based at Piazza Università 21, 07100, Sassari; the person responsible for data processing is the General Director, Dr. Guido Croci.
