CONTEST RULES

Art. 1 The Contest

The University of Sassari (hereinafter, UNISS) and the Erasmus Student Network Sassari Association (hereinafter, ESN Sassari), launch the 3rd "Frame your Erasmus Experience" Photo Contest, within the framework of the Erasmus Days 2022 Initiative.

Art. 2 The objective

The main objective of the contest is to raise awareness on the importance of the Erasmus experience among both incoming and outgoing students and UNISS staff through the use of images.

The most significant works of the competition will be used by the Institution in its promotional and communication activities.

Art. 3 The topic

Competitors are requested to represent their Erasmus experience by relying on the language of images.

The photographic materials presented must offer the personal point of view of the contestant and must be original and unpublished.

Art. 4 Participation requirements

The contest is free of charge.

Participation is open to all incoming and outgoing students, former Erasmus students enrolled at UNISS or university staff who have carried out their mobility in the academic year 2021/2022.

Participants must declare ownership of the intellectual property rights of the images submitted, as well as their consent to their free use by UNISS and ESN Sassari for communication, awareness-raising and non-profit making promotional activities.

The members of the selection board, as well as all those who, in their capacities, collaborate in the organization of the contest are excluded from the contest.

Art. 5. Rules of participation

Registration for the contest must be made by sending the proposed image to presidente@esnsassari.it and by filling in the release form at <https://forms.gle/BT6bsAEVDsUCo7bd6> no later than 3 October 2022. The release will be sent automatically to the jury.

Art. 7 Privacy, authorship and right of exclusion

Each participant is responsible for the material submitted to the contest. Therefore, each participant undertakes to exclude any liability of the organizers of the aforementioned contest towards third parties, also towards any subjects depicted in the photographs. The participants must inform any interested parties (persons portrayed) in the cases and in the manner provided for by the GDPR (or GDPR in English General Data Protection Regulation), officially Regulation (EU) no. 2016/679D, as well as obtain consent to their dissemination. In no case may the images sent contain data that can be classified as sensitive. Each participant also declares that he/she is the sole author of the images sent and that they are original, unpublished and not being published, that they do not harm the rights of third parties and that, if they portray subjects for whom consent or authorization is required, he/she has obtained it.

The organizers also reserve the right to exclude from the contest and not to publish the non-compliant photos in the form and subject to what is indicated in this notice or to the commonly recognized rules on public morality, ethics, and decency, for the protection of participants and visitors.

Therefore, images deemed offensive, improper, and harmful to human and social rights or with the presence of recognisable underage will not be allowed.

Art. 8 Jury and evaluation criteria

The jury consists of 6 (six) members:

The images received will be transmitted to the Jury on 4 October 2022, which will select a maximum of 6 (3 for the student category and 3 for the staff category) by 5 October 2022. The jury will evaluate the ability to interpret the topic, originality, creativity, the quality of the photograph and the artistic content of the images presented.

The jury's opinion will be unquestionable. In the event of a tie between the candidates, the jury chairman's vote will count as two votes.

Art. 9 Selection and prizes

The images will be published between 6-13 October 2022 online on the Instagram page @esn_sassari managed by ESN Sassari and relaunched by @unissgram between 6-13 October 2022.

The two images that will obtain the highest number of "likes" (one for the student category and one for the staff category) on the Instagram profile @esn_sassari, will be declared winners. The winners will receive a telephone call or an e-mail to the address indicated in the release form to receive their prize.

The competition will end on 13 October 2022 at 23:59.

On 14 October, during the Erasmus Welcome Day, which will be held at the Aula Magna of the University of Sassari at 6 pm, the winners of the contest will be announced.

Student Category

1st prize: € 300-worth refund on the purchase of technological material (the purchase receipt must be submitted to ESN Sassari)

Staff Category

1st prize: € 300-worth refund on the purchase of technological material (the purchase receipt must be submitted to ESN Sassari)

Art. 10 – Final provisions

Participation in the contest implies the acceptance of these rules and the unquestionability of the jury's decisions. The competitors authorise UNISS and ESN Sassari to publish the submitted material and to make it available to the public. Whenever possible, the author's name will be mentioned, whenever one of his works is used in the manner indicated above.
