

Call for contributions on intercultural dialogue issues

Background

In March 2019, UNIMED and the Anna Lindh Foundation signed a Partnership Agreement to deepen their cooperation at the Euro-Mediterranean level and to develop a joint work on Research on Intercultural Trends and Media through initiatives involving academics, students, journalists, activists and experts from different backgrounds.

In this framework, the Anna Lindh Foundation recently launched the [Intercultural Dialogue Resource Centre](#), a hub gathering all the initiatives and resources related to Intercultural Dialogue in the EuroMed region issued from the work of the civil society, the media and the academia, to make them available and inspiring for everyone.

Academic contribution to the Intercultural Dialogue Resource Centre

UNIMED is responsible of feeding the Resource Centre by mapping relevant think tanks and research centres and identifying contributions (i.e. publications, events, good practices, learning activities, resources and audiovisual materials) in line with the thematic priorities of the Anna Lindh Foundation in the EuroMed region:

Education: intercultural learning

Cities: mobility, migration and intercultural cities

Media: cross-cultural reporting and the role of media in shaping perceptions

Culture: arts and translation for dialogue

Youth: youth exchanges and mutual perceptions

Gender: fighting gender and cultural stereotyping

UNIMED members are therefore invited to share:

a / articles already published

b / scientific articles/book reviews

c / research working papers

d / audiovisual contributions

dealing with intercultural relations in the EuroMed region.

Selection criteria

To be published, the contributions submitted to UNIMED and ALF must respond to the following criteria:

- Clearly tackle **intercultural issues** related to the six thematic priorities.
- Highlight the **role of intercultural dialogue** in addressing specific issues.
- Provide a **regional perspective** on the issue or a case-study/best practise related to a specific country.
- Avoid pure political dimension.
- In case of **articles, papers and book reviews**, they must be already published on dedicated journals, newspapers, magazines, collections or published online on the websites of relevant institutions, think tanks and research centers.
The author shall provide the ISBN or ISSN and the publisher copyright policy.
If the contribution is published on a fee-based support, the author can provide an abstract and the link to the platform where the contribution can be purchased.
- In case of **research working papers** not already published, the author shall provide an abstract along with a list of 4 potential peer-reviewers to be contacted for this task.
- In case of **audiovisual materials**, they must be already available on dedicated institutional webplatforms, such as universities / research centers / think tanks websites.
- Contributions can be provided in **original language** but must include an **abstract in English and/or French**.
