Selection


- English skills (at least B2 level in the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages)
- Letter of motivation, including in particular the applicant's interest in the topic
- Each participant will be asked to prepare a poster about services and service concepts offered in their field of work.
- Applications will be evaluated based on the applicant's job role and the country of the sending institution in order to ensure that everyone has the best possible opportunity to share their experiences and to assemble an internationally varied group of participants.
- Participation may be limited to one person per university depending on the number of applications.
